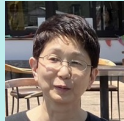

I studied abroad at Kyungnam University in South Korea for three months, improving my Korean and English.

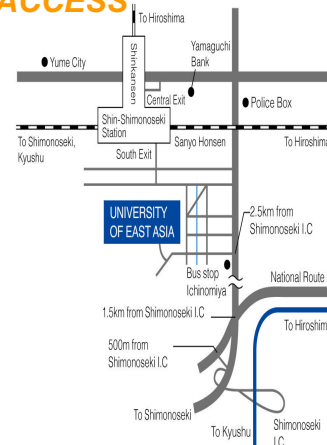
Although I initially struggled with Korean, active practice in class and with friends helped me understand daily conversations.
